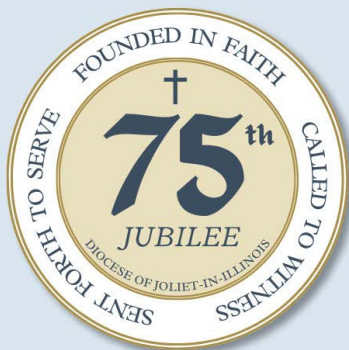

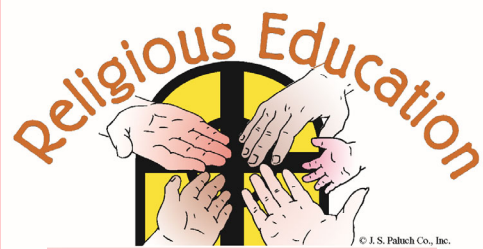

## Vocations

Last Sunday we celebrated Good Shepherd Sunday, also designated as the World Day of Prayer for Vocations. Thank you to all who prayed. Will you continue to pray? You might be wondering, why do we pray for vocations?

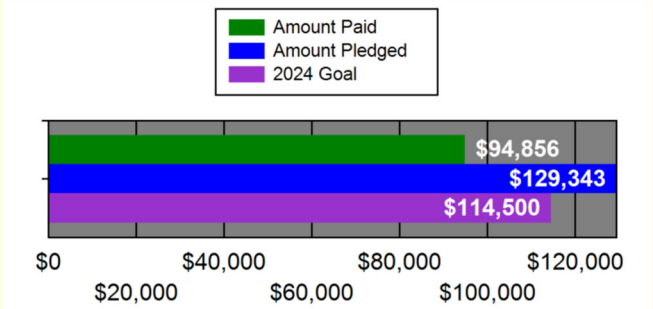
