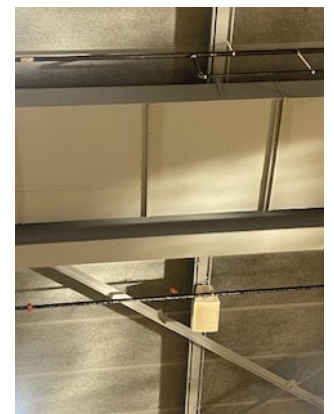
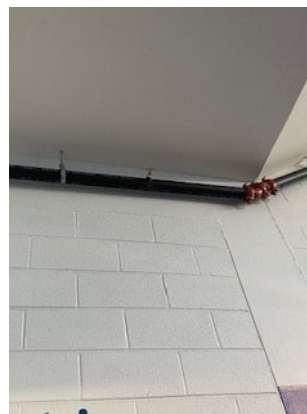


Summer Work

You may have noticed how busy our campus was over the summer. We continued to work on improvements in most of our buildings and all around the campus.

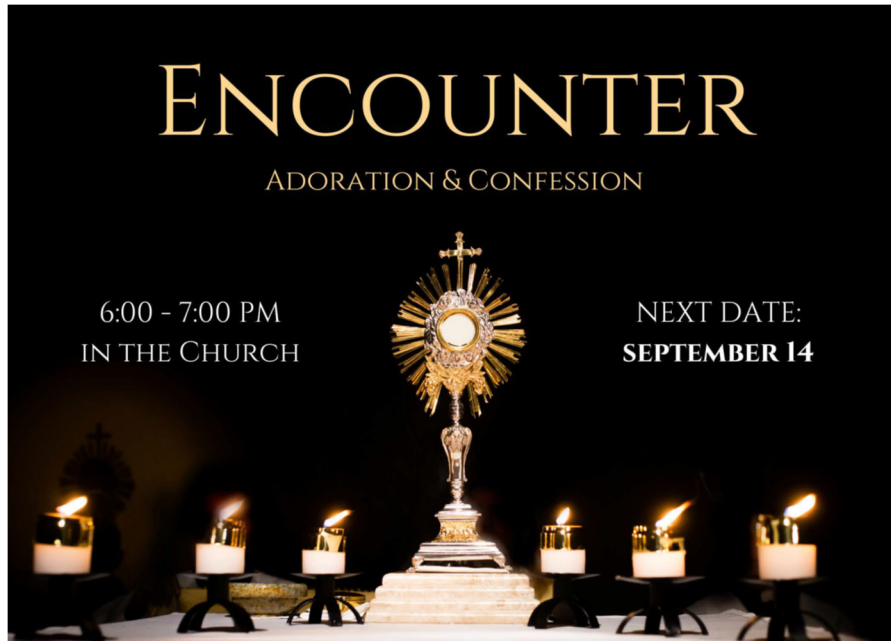
The Parish Center Building (which houses our Sacred Heart Chapel, Gymnasium, and Plunkett Hall) received the following updates:

- The original windows were installed in 1961 in the gym. The asbestos caulk around these windows was abated and new windows were installed.
- A fire alarm system required by city of Elmhurst was installed. As of right now, the entire building has brand new fire alarms.
- The entire gym, weight room, locker rooms, stairwells, stage, and below the stage all were sprinkled, as required by the City of Elmhurst. The entire PC building is now fully equipped with sprinklers.
- New fire rated doors were installed to all the entrances of the gym.
- The building was completely cleaned and paint touch ups were done as needed.

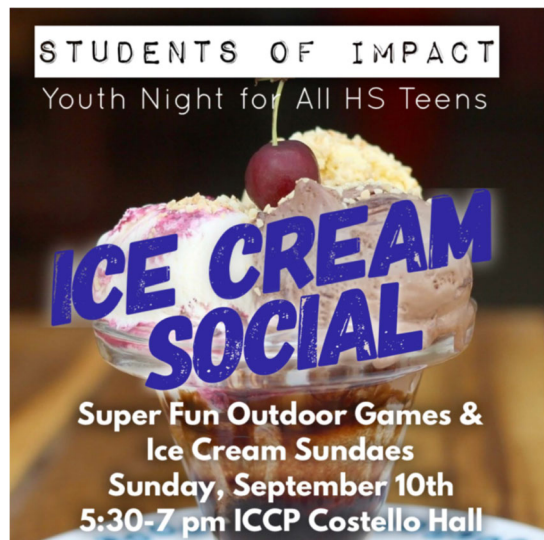

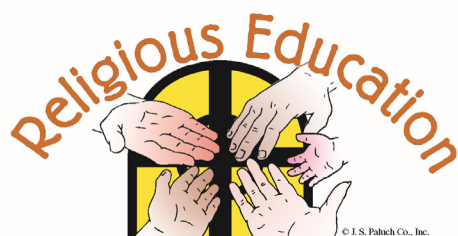

SUMMER FOOD PANTRY NEEDS

We continue to struggle to obtain the food we need through the Northern Illinois Food Bank. The following items are most needed and requested in our pantry right now: cereal, pancake mix, pasta and pasta sauce, milk, canned fruit and vegetables, full-size condiments, salad dressing, toothpaste, body soap/wash, shampoo, personal hygiene products, laundry detergent, paper towels, and dish soap. Items may be dropped off

during our pantry hours, 10-noon M-TH, or during normal business hours at the rectory.

Fresh produce from your summer gardens would also be most appreciated! Fresh produce is in short supply through the Northern Illinois Food Bank. If you have an abundance of tomatoes, corn, squash, berries or other home-grown goodies, our clients would love to have some! Thank you!

GOOD USED CAR DONATIONS NEEDED

IC Daybreak Transitional Housing partners with Bridge Communities, in our transitional housing ministry. Program requirements specify that a potential client be employed full-time.

A significant barrier to finding and keeping employment is unreliable transportation. Many clients enter our program without a car or have a car that needs extensive and costly repairs. Bridge relies on donations to provide cars to these families.

Reliable transportation is a necessity, as public transportation in DuPage County is limited. One of our current clients is currently in need of a good used vehicle.

Requirements include attendance at a **Protecting God's Children workshop**, currently offered online, a current **background check, acknowledgement of the diocesan policies** on the sexual abuse of

minors, completion of a **Volunteer Application** and, in some cases, **Mandated Reporter training**. Please sign into your **Virtus** account www.virtusonline.org and check the "Summary" tab to verify whether you are compliant. The summary tab will indicate which items need to be addressed for full compliance. **If you need help with your User Name or password retrieval, please contact the Virtus Help Desk at 888-847-8870. If you have a Virtus account in another diocese, the Help Desk can transfer it for you.**

If you do not yet have a **Virtus** account, please go to IC website's main page and click on the Virtus / Protecting God's Children image, which will direct you to instructions for establishing an account. **If you do not remember where or when you took your Protecting God's Children workshop, please contact Pam Stefik at 630-530-3497. Do not guess at the location or date, as your account cannot be processed with incorrect information.** Individuals who do not have a **Virtus** account or fail to comply with Diocesan requirements cannot volunteer in ministries involving children or vulnerable adults. If you require additional information or have any other questions, please contact Pam Stefik at 630-530-3497. Thank you for your commitment to protecting God's children at Immaculate Conception.

NOTICE TO ALL CURRENT / ACTIVE VOLUNTEERS

Effective August 1, 2023, the Diocese of Joliet has implemented Continuing Education modules for those whose Protecting God's Children workshop was taken three or more years ago. Continuing Education will then be required every three years. You will receive an e-mail from the Diocese of Joliet asking that you sign into your Virtus account and undertake the assigned training. Anyone who has not completed the required training within fourteen days from the date of notice will be considered non-compliant and may be prevented from future ministry / school volunteer opportunities. 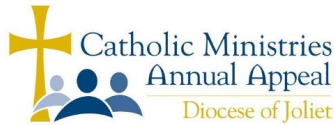

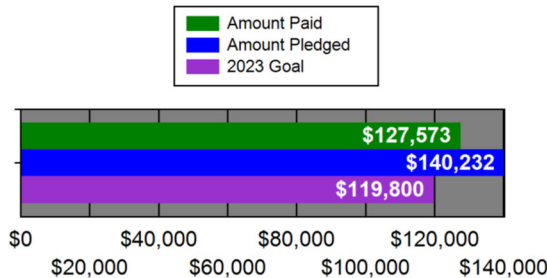
