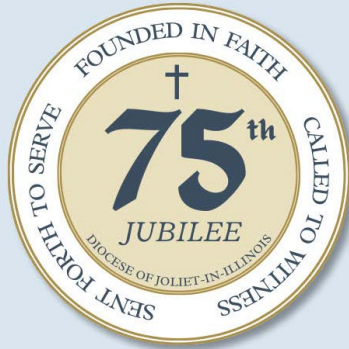

Originally, PACZKI were made for practical reasons, to use up the sugar and eggs which were prohibited during Lent.

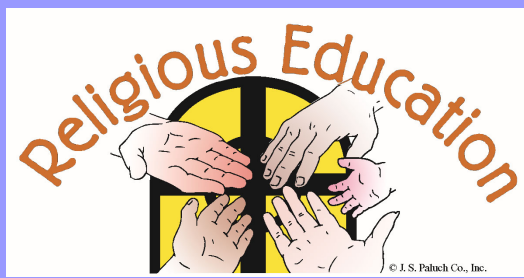

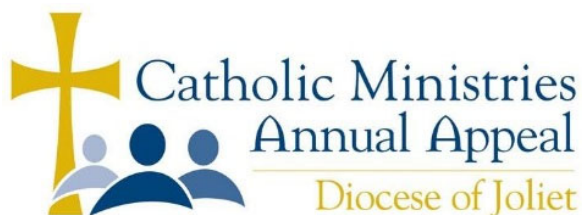
