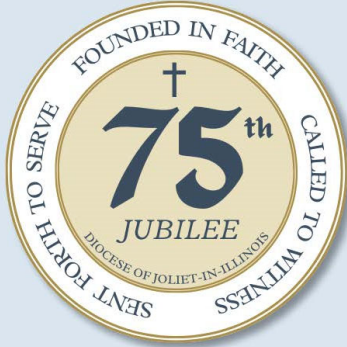

Reflection: The Living Bread
Thomas Merton

To strengthen our position and to sink our roots deeper into the charity of Christ, it is necessary that we seek opportunities to adore Christ in the Blessed Sacrament and to give testimony to our faith outside the time of Mass. Therefore we visit our churches in order to pray to him in silence and alone. We go to benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. We make Holy Hours, or we spend time alone in Adoration, by day or by night, before the sacramental Christ enthroned upon the altar. All these contacts deepen our awareness of the great mystery that is the very heart of the Church and open our souls to the influence of the Son of God “who gives life to whom he wills” (John 5:21).

God is calling his people into a new “Upper Room.” At the National Eucharistic Congress, the Church in the U.S. will gather in a way this generation has never seen—ready for the great outpouring of grace God desires to lavish upon his people. This is the beginning of a new chapter of Eucharistic faith in America. Will you be there?

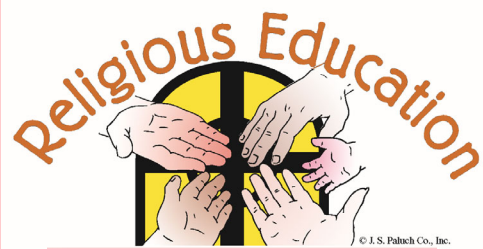

2024 1st Quarter Activity Report

The caring people of Elmhurst unite to provide compassionate assistance to people in need in our community.

EWAN ended 2023 with record numbers for total services, client assistance dollars, new clients in a year, and rents paid. What might we expect for 2024?

Our 1st Quarter statistics indicate that **new records** are continuing to be set. Comparing **Q1 2024** numbers to **Q1 2023** numbers, total services were **up** by **25.1%** from 339 to **424**; client assistance dollars were **up** by **49%** from \$52,983 to **\$78,946**; new clients were **up** by **53.6%** from 28 to **43**; and rents paid were **up** **61.4%** from \$34,246 to **\$55,280**. During the January – March 2024 period, rent payments alone accounted for 70% of the total client service expense, although March payments this year did come down by some 50% from last year. What an extraordinary expression of need!


