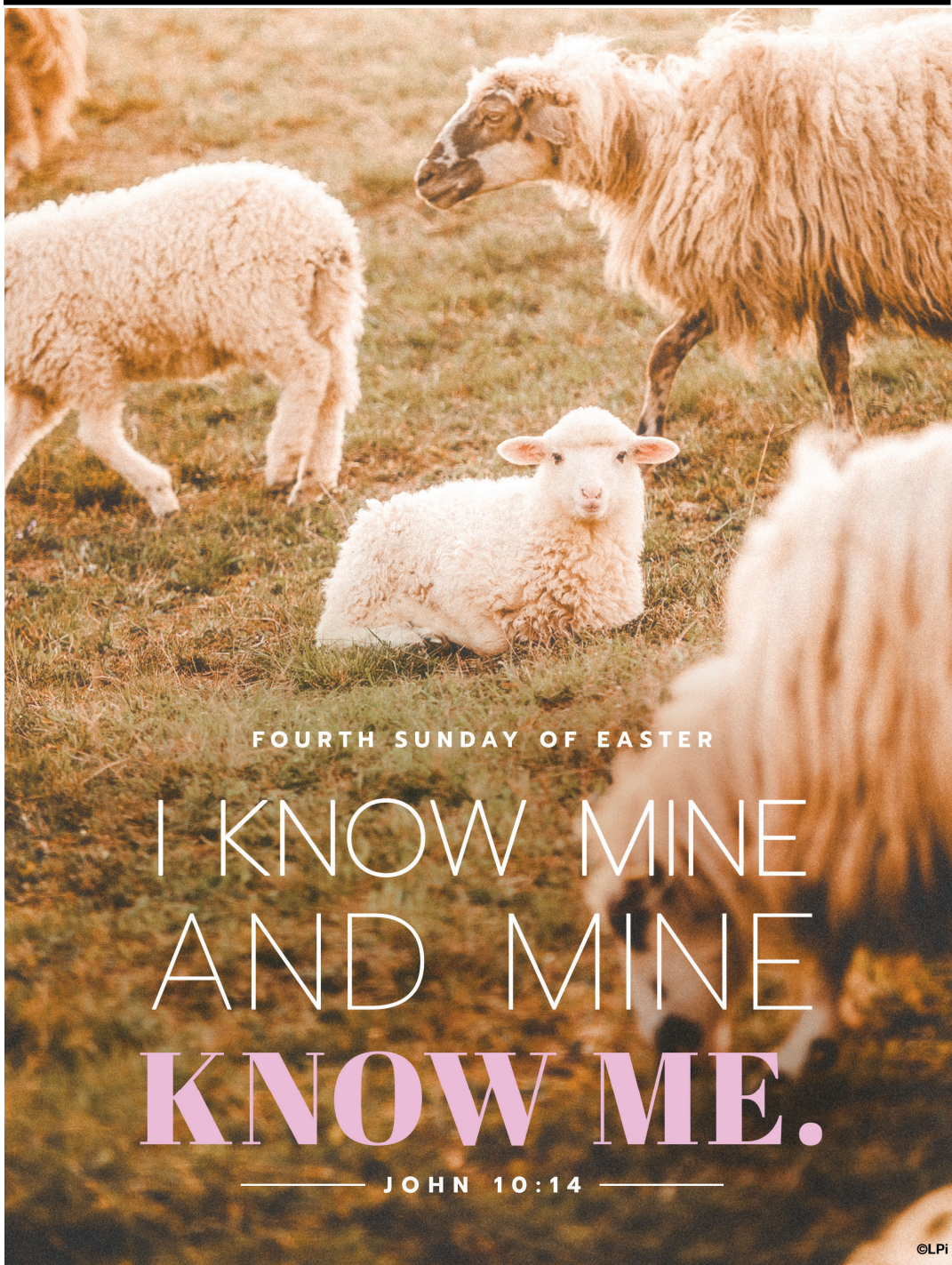

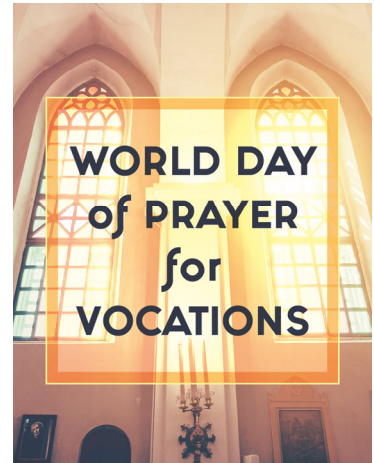
### World Day of Prayer for Vocations Sunday, April 21

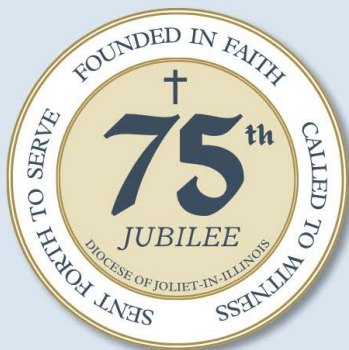

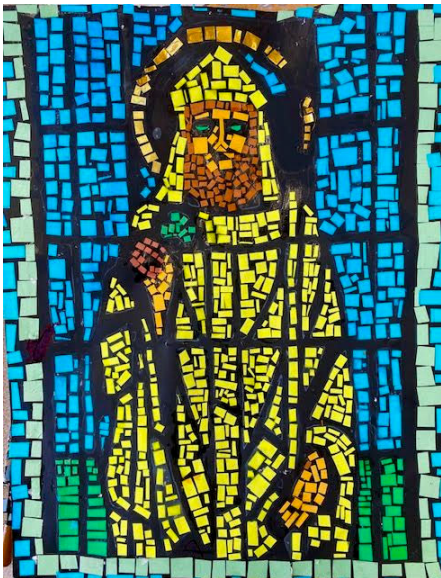

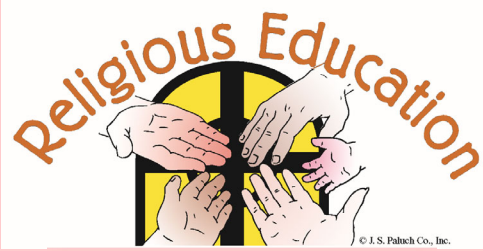

We would like to express our sincere gratitude to everyone who attended our Young Hearts for Life (YH4L) event. We are thrilled to announce that over 240 students from ICCP and IC Grade School attended this free ECG screening, which can potentially save lives. YH4L is the largest ECG screening program in the United States, and it provides a FREE heart screening called an electrocardiogram (ECG) to identify young adults (between the ages of 12 and 24) who may be at risk for Sudden Cardiac Death (SCD). Shockingly, more than 60 young adults die each week in the United States from SCD. Since 2006, YH4L has screened over 310,000 students and has identified more than 3,300 with previously undiagnosed heart conditions.

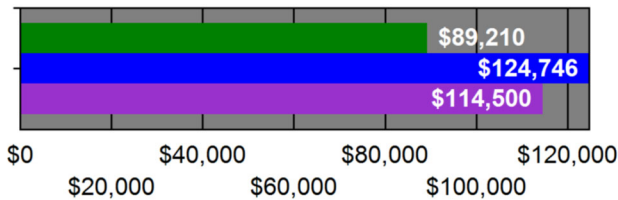
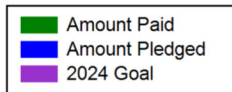
